 - a. HEERF I was disbursed in full to students on June 2, 2020.
 - b. All the HEERF I funds, \$87,048.00 were disbursed.
 - c. HEERF II funds of \$87,650.00 were disbursed in full to students on April 20,2021
 - d. HEERF III funds of \$29,440.00 were disbursed on September 2, 2021 and funds of \$46,080.00 were disbursed on September 28, 2021
- 4. The estimated total number of students at the institution who are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
 - a. HEERF I funds, \$87,048.00, were divided equally to the <u>68</u> students who applied and were eligible for the grant.
 - b. Each student received \$1,280.00. Each student was sent a check on June 2, 2020.
 - c. HEERF II funds, \$87,650.00, were disbursed by check to 56 students who met the eligibility requirements.
 - d. HEERF II funds were disbursed to Pell eligible students (38) receiving \$1,750.00 and non-eligible students (18) receiving \$1,1750.00.
 - e. HEERF III funds, \$29,440.00, were disbursed to 26 students with Pell eligible students (15) receiving \$1,200.00 and non-eligible students (11) receiving \$1,040.00. Additionally, \$46,080.00 was disbursed, with Pell eligible students (28) receiving \$1,200.00 and non-eligible students (12) receiving \$1,040.00.
 - f. HEERF III funds, \$82,600.00, were disbursed to 54 students with Pell eligible students (35) receiving \$1,600.00 and non-eligible students (19) receiving \$1,400.00 on 12/1/20221 (Q421).

- g. HEERF III funds, \$81,800.00, were disbursed to 54 students with Pell eligible students (35) receiving \$1,600.00 and non-eligible students (19) receiving \$1,400.00 on 1/14/2022 (Q122). \$800.00 from institutional funds was used to make up the balance.

 - a. 68 students received the HEERF I grant
 - b. 56 students received the HEERF II grant.
 - c. 66 students received the HEERF III grant.
 - d. 54 students received additional HEERF III grant.
